The implementation checklist for a headless CMS

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Project

- › What are the project requirements?
- › What is the goal of your project?
- › What is the desired outcome?
- › Who is the target audience?
- › How do you define the success of your project (KPIs)?
- › What are the project phases/milestones?
- › What's the project timeline/deadline? What's the expected date to go live?
- › Have you also included a testing period?
- › What do you think will be the greatest challenge with this project?
- › Do you see any potential risks (especially high risks) in this project?

Technology stack

- › Which third-party services do you plan to integrate?
- › Which microservices do you plan to implement (e.g., Search, Azure functions, Reporting, Monitoring, Bots, Voice assistant support, Social media, etc.)?
- › What frameworks/SDKs do you plan to use?
- › What platforms do you plan to support?
- › Where do you want to store your data (EU, US, or AUS data centers)?

What do you plan to use?

- › Secured API?
- › Preview functionality + Preview edit button?
- › Management API?
- › Tracking, segmentation, and personalization (including Custom Activity Tracking)?
- › Content Type Snippets (reusable collections of elements)?
- › Webhooks, caching?
- › Scheduled Publishing?

Collaboration

- › How many people are going to collaborate on this project?
- › What will their roles/permissions be (who will be allowed to create content, review, translate, or manage settings)?
- › Set up content element limitations, required elements, etc.
- › Map and customize workflows.
- › Configure Custom Roles.
- › Set up Preview and quick edits.
- › Try out Comments.
- › Have a look at Revisions.
- › Check out the visual comparison of Revisions.

Put together some numbers

- › The expected number of content items (including modular components)
- › The expected number of content types
- › The expected number of languages
- › The expected number of assets

Before you start with the implementation

- › Consider using our **consulting services** to validate your **requirements** and get **recommendations** for implementation/architecture/integrations or caching.
- › The consulting team can also help you with **content migration, setting up content models, environment setup**, or give you **recommendations for integrations**.

Content

- › Define and validate your content models.
- › Add guidelines concerning content elements/content type levels.

- › What are the sources from which you need to import the content (another CMS, a third-party tool, a file)?
- › How do you plan to implement and work with the metadata?
- › How are you going to tag and organize the content (using Sitemap, Taxonomy)?
- › Where do you plan to build relationships between content items (using Modular components)?
